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Resolved, that Wasatch Presbyterian Church Corporation convey by gift its interest in the property, known as the “Gully Property” . . . to Salt Lake City Corporation on condition that said property be developed, used, and maintained exclusively as a public park, and whenever said property shall hereafter cease to be used or maintained for park purposes, title to the property shall revert to Wasatch Presbyterian Church Corporation, its successors and assigns.

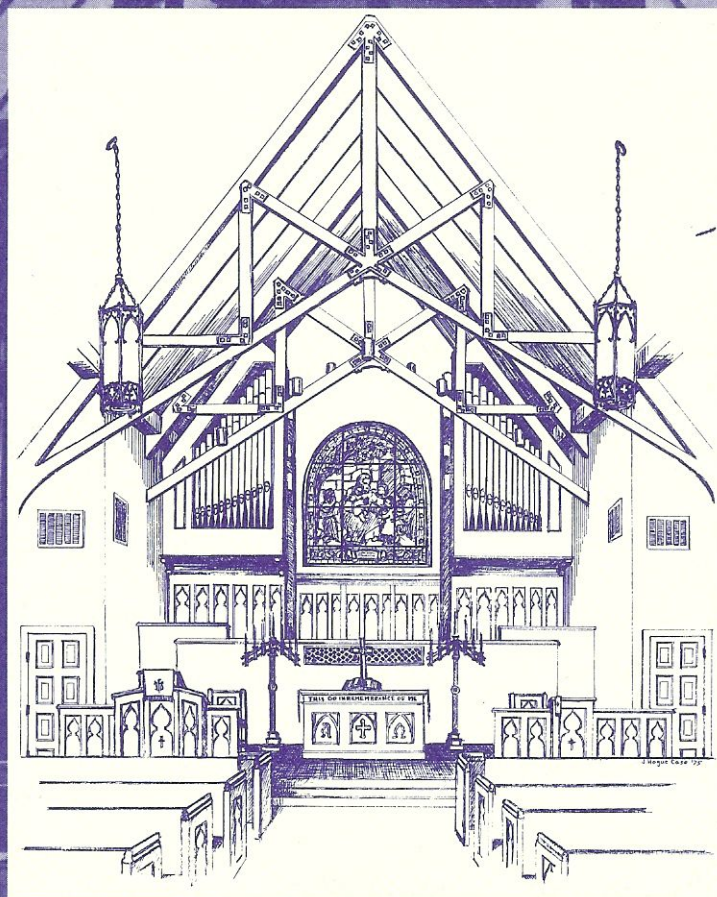
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Dad [Ray T. Woolsey] got the property [where the park now sits] for the church, and I don't think we paid very much for it. Through politics and the like, Dad convinced them that we should have that property. He'd always envisioned that Wasatch Church should have a place where kids could have activities—a gym or something. All of the ward houses had their own recreation facilities. But the only place that the Protestants had was Westminster Gym, and that was booked up to the eyeballs. That was what he envisioned, and I'm sure he'd be very pleased with the development that's out there now.

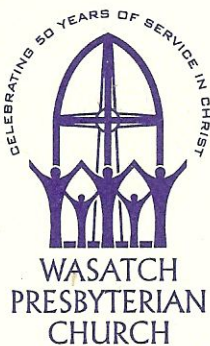
